Catapult Competition

Patrols will compete on appearance, accuracy, and distance.

Troops will need to design and practice assembling, disassembling, and reassembling their catapults. Design and building practice before camporee is strongly recommended and encouraged.



Basic Rules:

- All catapults must be constructed on site. Each patrol will have time to build their catapult on Saturday.
- The basket/sling/throwing arm may be preassembled and brought to the camporee.
- Patrols must supply their own materials.
- Patrols are welcome to use their own designs.
- Absolutely no launching of projectiles at human or animal targets. No launching of real animals, scouts, or Scoutmasters.
- Each troop's adult leaders are responsible for making sure that their scouts' catapults are safe and that scouts use them safely.
- Catapults can not be more than 6 feet tall including the throwing arm.
- Projectiles will be provided for the competition—they will be soft, roundish shaped and between 2"-2.75".

Royal Court Dinner Competition

The Royal Court gets very hungry after a day of fun at the Festival of the Scouting Kingdom. There will be 3 categories for each patrol to choose from when they enter the Dinner Competition. The categories are: appetizers, main course/dish, and dessert.

Patrols are asked to prepare enough of their dish for 10 Royal Court members to sample and judge. Entries need to be delivered to the dining hall between 5:30 PM and 5:45 PM.

Heraldry Competition

Each Unit/Patrol is asked to bring a flag or shield for their unit to camp. Be creative in your representation of your Patrol. Flags/Shields need to be displayed at entrance of campsite for judging. Judges will make their way around camp during the day on Saturday after the opening ceremony.

Archery Competition

Each Unit/Patrol will be assigned a time at the archery range during the Saturday morning activities. Points are awarded based on accuracy. Adjusted scores will be calculated by averaging the scores of each Scout in the patrol.

Flag Retirement

There will be a flag retirement ceremony as part of the closing campfire.

Closing Campfire Skits

Each Unit/Patrol is asked to present a skit at the closing campfire. Please sign up for the skit by the end of lunch on Saturday. All skits need to be reviewed by adult leaders in charge for Scout appropriateness.
