## **PAYMENT AND REGISTRATION**

Team Registration Fee: \$180.00, amount paid in full \$\_\_\_\_\_

Registration must be filled out completely to be accepted. Fees can be paid by cash, check made out to Green Mountain Council, or credit card. You may call and pay by credit card over the phone. Payments made by credit cards have a 3% fee associated with it.

- 1. Teams, submit a completed entry accompanied by the \$180 entry fee, payable to: Green Mountain Council, no later than 4:30 pm on Friday, September 14, 2018.
- 2. Only one entry may be filed per team. Late entries will be accepted and placed on an alternate's list to fill spots if they become available. Entries will not be accepted unless; they are accompanied by the correct entry fee. Registrations may be sent ahead of fee, but your spot will not be guaranteed until we receive your payment. All checks must be made payable to the Green Mountain Council.
- 3. WITHDRAWALS- Teams who have applied to participate in the event and wish to withdraw for any reason MUST notify the Tournament Director by email: Cameo.Lamb@scouting.org or by telephone at 802-793-6445 prior to Wednesday, September 19, 2018. Teams who fail to follow this procedure will be listed as a NO SHOW. Refer to refund policy.
- 4. REFUND POLICY- If a team wishes to pull out of the tournament by 9/19/2018 then they will receive a full refund. Any requests after that will be denied (unless extreme circumstances have occurred) and the entry fee will be considered a donation made by the team. If the tournament is canceled for any reason by the Tournament Director, Cameo Lamb then every team's Point of Contact will be notified and the team will be given a full refund.
- 5. RAIN POLICY- The tournament director will make every effort to work with local facilities personnel to have fields in playable condition for our tournaments; however, we all know that weather is out of our control. It is our intent to have a fair rain refund policy. The general refund policy is outlined above.
- RETURN CHECKS All checks returned due to insufficient funds will carry a \$35.00 service charge. If a team has a returned check they will not be able to participate until the balance has been paid.

The Fall Diamond Co-Ed Softball Classic is a new softball tournament that will be hosted annually by Long Trail District of Green Mountain Council. Our program is a non-profit that is supported by donations made by Scouting families and the public.

## Rules, Rules Rules

- ASA rules apply
- Players must be 18+
- 10 players per team maximum/9 players minimum
  - o 5 Men and 5 Women
  - o 5 Men and 4 Women OR 5 Women and 4 Men
- Maximum 2 extra hitters
  - o 1 man and 1 woman
- No half metal/half wood bats (corn dogs) allowed
- Gender alternating batting order
- Over the fence homeruns cost \$1 per run
- Must use own bats
- Balls provided
- BY and winning teams required to ump games or be disqualified
- If team is scheduled to ump, two players must be provided
- Umps are volunteers and make the final call
- Count starts as 1 1
- 7 inning games, but a new inning can't start after an hour unless it is tied
- 15 run rule after the 4<sup>th</sup> inning
- 10 run rule after the 5<sup>th</sup> inning
- If ball hits the mat it's a strike
- 1 courtesy runner an inning, but batter must make it to first on their own
- No alcohol allowed on the field or in the dugouts
